

# Spanish Teacher Workshop

*“Cinema in the Spanish language classroom”*

The workshop will include a general introduction to film techniques, and explanation of critical vocabulary to discuss cinema in Spanish. The session will offer a general presentation of the cultural and historical context of the film selected for analysis, which participants would have seen already. A guided discussion after the viewing session will elaborate on the major points of interest, the representation of cultural ideas and identities, relevant historical and political issues, and the opportunities to enhance students’ cultural awareness and communication skills. Handouts will be provided with relevant vocabulary, critical reviews, and additional bibliography.
