Spanish Immersion – Salamanca

This programme offers teachers of Spanish the opportunity to improve their Spanish language and cultural understanding with a 2 week immersion trip to Salamanca, Spain. The course consists of 40 hours of Spanish Language and Culture classes and a homestay experience.

Programme content

- ◆ Spanish language and cultural classes at the University of Salamanca
- ◆ extra-curricular activities such as workshops, cultural visits and trips to historical sites
- ◆ opportunities for both, homestay and residence accommodation during the 2 weeks

Programme outline

The course includes 4 hours of classes per day

- ◆ Spanish language (2 hours)
- ◆ Choice of: contemporary Spanish history; Spanish culture; business Spanish; English-Spanish translation; analysis of literary texts; speaking and writing (1 hour)
- ◆ Choice of: contemporary Spanish literature; history of Spanish art; Spanish economy and society; oral skills (1 hour)

Extra-curricular activities:

- ◆ cooking workshop
- ◆ two cultural visits to the city of Salamanca
- ◆ visit to the historical library of the University of Salamanca
- ◆ two day trips to two different cities

Eligibility

Preference will be given to registered teachers who

- ◆ Previous engagement in the Ministry of Education PLD/ Spanish workshops
- ◆ Are involved in levels 1 to 4/Years 7-10 of the Learning Languages area of the curriculum
- ◆ Are currently teaching Spanish
