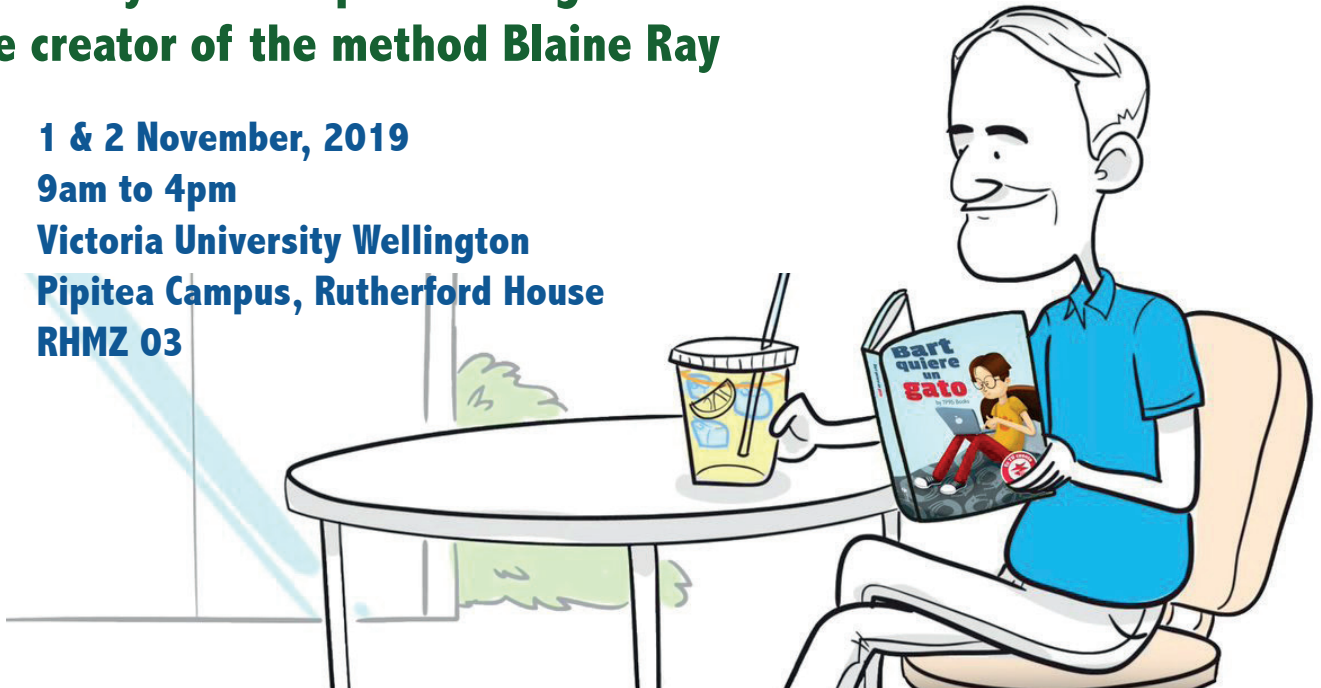




Teach for success with TPRS
